For many years Robert L. Shegog kept parts of his life a secret.

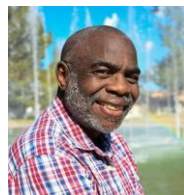
The native of Michigan reveals these truths — that he is gay and that he was diagnosed with HIV in 1986 — in his new autobiography, “Wrestling with the Truth.”
